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AVAILABLE LESSONS & RATES

Lessons are available for the piano, guitar, and electric bass, along with a classical study on the double bass, piano, and violin. Please contact Todd with any questions prior to purchasing any equipment.

A rate of \$65 per lesson is offered to students. Students may elect to pay by check at a rate of \$220 for four lessons.

All methods that will be used were chosen after years of research, based on student preference and their growth in each of these methods. For convenience, a supply of books and accessories are usually kept available.

All students are expected to keep a manuscript notebook of their studies. This personal log book will include additional exercises and materials written during the lesson.

A metronome may be suggested to help students with tempo and rhythm. Also, a tuner may be suggested to help new ones develop a better sense of pitch.



WHAT MAKES THESE PRIVATE LESSONS UNIQUE?

Students may study in a well-equipped studio or in the privacy of their own home.

Students are encouraged to set obtainable but challenging goals while learning at their own pace.

This along with the supplementation of original material allows students to feel motivated and not threatened.

While traditional methods limit practice material to the confines of a lesson book, this environment allows students to explore all types of music, past and present.
